- Reluctance to attend due to emotional factors

YELLOW LIGHT

Child may go to school


- Chronic runny nose
- Lingering cough
- Mild headache
- Muscle aches
- Sore throat without fever

RED LIGHT

Child does not attend school

- · Fever 100 degrees F. or higher in the morning
- More than one episode of vomiting or diarrhea
- Untreated ear infection, symptoms of pink eye, impetigo, or ringworm (unless area can be covered)
- Chicken Pox until all lesions are crusted and dry (usually within 7-10 days)
- · Rash with fever
- Untreated head lice or nits present
- Sore throat with fever
- · Runny nose with thick green mucous
